Detailed Report on the 5th Anniversary of “नशा मुक्त भारत अभियान”

Purpose: Mass Pledge Against Drug Abuse

Background and Objective

The “नशा मुक्त भारत अभियान” is a flagship campaign initiated by the Government of India with the objective of creating mass awareness about the harmful effects of drug abuse and mobilizing youth to be change-makers in society. On its **5th anniversary**, Govt. College Karsog, through its **Anti-Drug Cell**, organized a multifaceted awareness programme aimed at engaging students intellectually, creatively, and emotionally to strengthen their resolve against substance abuse.

Participation and Attendance

The programme recorded **the presence of over 130 students**, along with the college Principal, faculty members, non-teaching staff, and the distinguished guest speaker **Shri Bhopal Sharma**, Tehsil Welfare Officer, Karsog. The active and vibrant participation reflected the college community’s deep commitment to the cause.

1. Opening and Welcome Address
