Suggestions/Comments

Infrastructure is not well maintained and rooms for classes especially pg. classes are not available
New ideas for institutional growth and development from young and newly inducted staff should be incorporated in meeting with IQAC.
1. No cultural functions, talks, or any other activities, apart from regular classes, should take place before 1 PM in the College Campus. 2. Active participation of the College Students' Association should be encouraged to enhance leadership skills and a sense of belonging among students. 3. If a committee fails to complete the assigned work or performs poorly, the convener should be asked to provide an explanation, not the members. 4. Apart from few very important functions like Annual function, CSCA functioned. no other function or activity should take place for a duration of more than 2 hours.
Sitting capacity of library should be increased and financial grants should be provided to teachers for participation and organising conference etc. and promoting research.
More emphasis should be laid on the practical aspects of learning.





Further, about 65.3% faculty believes that employability is given weightages in curriculum design	More emphasis should be put on employability issues in curriculum design.
Admission process	96.1% faculty respondents believe that adopted procedure of admission is effective.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Few of the facilities like deletion of any form filled wrongly and updating of student data by the respective faculty member should be added to the faculty form verification tab.➤ The ICT facilities should be provided to the students in the campus for filling admission form and few teachers may be deputed to help them out in computer lab.



Moreover teachers are also encouraged to carry out research, organize/ participate in/workshop etc.	<p>➤ Faculty members would be further encouraged for research projects, participation / organizing seminars/workshops etc.</p> <p>➤ Further IQAC will act as bridge to involve all aspects of growth in research and innovation, especially conferences and Faculty development Programmers as per new needs so that teaching-learning process can become more productive.</p>
Examination and evaluation	Most of the faculty members believe that examination and evaluation system in college is effective.	<p>➤ The feedback was discussed with all departments and was directed to strengthen the internal evaluation process by making it more transparent through e-mode by using website.</p>
Library	96.2% faculty believes that Library resources are utilized properly by faculty as well as students and the timing of the library is sufficient as per rural background of the college.	<p>➤ New Text books, reference and new competitive books may be incorporated to strengthen the library.</p>

Infrastructure/ Labs	84.6% believes that class room, furniture, infrastructure facilities including toilet facilities etc. are adequate. The labs are adequately equipped too.	<p>➤ Auditorium work should be faster and options to make staff quarters should be explored.</p> <p>➤ Necessary guidelines to the Building Fund committee were given to improve existing toilet facility for staff and campus cleanliness by conducting a meeting with them.</p> <p>➤ The IQAC was directed to include new smart class room's proposal in next year prospective plan (Session 2024-25).</p>
Clean water resources	80.8% faculty believes that clean water facility adequately provide for all institution.	➤ The campus beautification committees were directed to install water-cooler in sports block.
Sports facility	50% faculty believes that sports facilities are reported as adequate by the members, 34.6% faculty members are neutral about the same. However, there is a scope for improvement as 15.4% respondents disagrees with this parameter.	➤ The sports committees were directed to find out the appropriate place for volleyball and basketball pitch.
