## 13 February , 2022

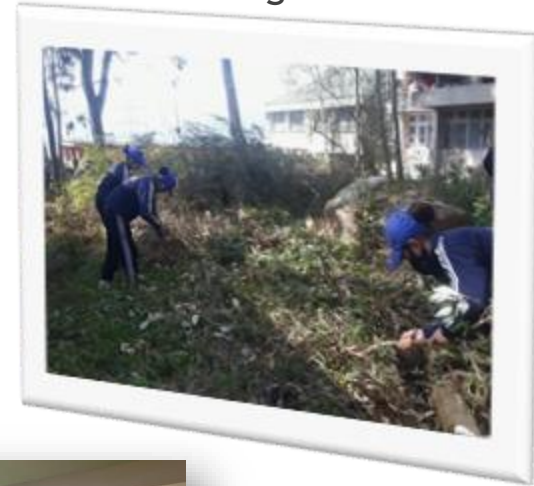
