



Course wise respondents (%)




Year wise respondents (%)









PARENTS FEEDBACK BASED ACTION TAKEN REPORT (ATR)

The comprehensive review on the feedback was done by analysing every minute aspect of the feedback based on graphically and percentage based analysis compiled by IQAC. The following measures were taken: -

Criterion	Feedback analysis	Action Taken
Admission procedure	About 97 % parents agree that the admission procedure is very good however 3% rates it average.	More emphasis should be given to user friendly interface related with admission software.
Infrastructure / Lab facility	85.8% parents believe that that the Infrastructure / Lab facility is effective for teaching learning process. However 13.2% rates it average.	 IQAC was instructed to look into more improvements measures related to infrastructure and lab facilities specially more number of smart classrooms, digital panels etc. The sanitation staff is directed to maintain the cleanliness and hygiene of college and girl hostel. The Superintendent will regularly monitor the above.
Library	91.3% parents believe that that the Infrastructure / Lab facility is effective for teaching learning process. However 7.6% rate it average.	➤ IQAC may purchase relevant new text books, reference and competitive books to strengthen the library. Further they may look to strengthen digitalization of library resources and services.
Counselling and Guidance Activities	90.2% parents believe that the counselling and guidance activities are up to the mark. However,7.6% have rated it as average	➤ In this regard the Career Counselling Cell is directed to increase the activities like seminars, invited talks, training programme so as more effectiveness may be inculcated for students support.
Information and Communication Technology	84% Parents believe that the use of information and communication technology is adequate in the college while 14% have rated it average.	 IQAC may increase the bandwidth of broadband and number of internet connections. Faculty members will encourage students to engage in activities involving the use of ICT.
College Website	91.3% Parents believe that college website is efficient while 6.5 % believe that it is average.	➤ IQAC may try to make the interface of the website more users friendly and will update all the activities/information of the college regularly on the website.

Academic discipline	90.8% parents believe that academic discipline of the college is up to the mark. However, 8.7% believe that there is scope of improvement.	All the faculty members will ensure effectiveness and punctuality in lectures, practical's and other curricular activities.
Improvement in soft skills, knowledge and ethics	87 % parents believe that soft skills, knowledge and ethics are up to the mark. However, 12% believe that there is scope of improvement.	 IQAC may propose to organize invited talks/ seminars/ workshops on soft skill and ethics to improve soft skills, knowledge and ethics among students. Additional improvement can be achieved by involving students in extension activities related to society.
Evaluation and Feedback Mechanism	91.4 % parents believe that evaluation and feedback mechanism are up to the mark. However, 7.6% believe that there is scope of improvement.	VIQAC may take measures to indulge more number of parents in PTA meetings so that face to face interaction with teachers, visit to college facilities etc. can be achieved. Further, their suggestions to overcome the shortcomings and improve the college facility can be incorporated.
