# Detailed Report on the 5th Anniversary of "नशा मुक्त भारत अभियान"

Date: 13th August 2025

**Venue:** College Hall / Conference Hall **Purpose:** Mass Pledge Against Drug Abuse

#### **Background and Objective**

The "नशा मुक्त भारत अभियान" is a flagship campaign initiated by the Government of India with the objective of creating mass awareness about the harmful effects of drug abuse and mobilizing youth to be change-makers in society. On its 5th anniversary, Govt. College Karsog, through its Anti-Drug Cell, organized a multifaceted awareness programme aimed at engaging students intellectually, creatively, and emotionally to strengthen their resolve against substance abuse.

## **Participation and Attendance**

The programme recorded **the presence of over 130 students**, along with the college Principal, faculty members, non-teaching staff, and the distinguished guest speaker **Shri Bhopal Sharma**, Tehsil Welfare Officer, Karsog. The active and vibrant participation reflected the college community's deep commitment to the cause.

## **Programme Proceedings**

#### 1. Opening and Welcome Address

The event commenced with a formal welcome by **Dr. Lomeshwar**, Convenor of the Anti-Drug Cell. In his address, he:
